VOLVO OCEAN RACE – PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE SUPPORT PILES (RIVER CORRIB)

The Galway Harbour Company hereby reminds mariners, ship owners, fishermen, leisure boats operators, canoeist, swimmers and all operators of craft that the temporary pedestrian walkway support piles which were placed in the River Corrib as part of the preparations for Galway's finale of the Volvo Ocean Race 2012 are still in situ.

Mariners are advised to proceed with extreme caution when navigating in the vicinity of the river corrib and the support piles which are located as shown in the attached drawing. Mariners and swimmers and not to navigate, swim, kayak, canoe upstream of the exclusion zone.
